Name of Commemorative day, holiday	Date	Day	Description of how the holiday is celebrated — a day off; to take the day off at a later date and adjustment of office hours
Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	January 1	Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Lunar New Year's Eve	February 13	Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As it falls on a Saturday, February 17 (Wednesday) should be the day off to make it up.
Spring Festival	February 14 February 15 February 16 February 17 February 18 February 19	Sunday Monday Tuesday Wednesday Thursday Friday	Three days off from February 14 to 16 in accordance with established rules. As one of Spring Festival falls on a Sunday, February 18 (Thursday) should be the day off to make it up. February 19 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; February 6 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Peace Memorial Day	February 28	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, a deferred day off is not allowed.
Tomb-sweeping Day	April 5	Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.

Labor Day	May 1	Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Saturday, a deferred day off is not allowed.
Dragon Boat Festival	June 16	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Mid-autumn Festival	September 22	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 10	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, a deferred day off is not allowed.
