Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	January 1	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, a deferred day off is not allowed.
Lunar New Year's Eve	January 22	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As it falls on Sunday, January 26 (Thursday) should be the day off to make it up.
Spring Festival	January 23 January 24 January 25 January 26 January 27	Monday Tuesday Wednesday Thursday Friday	Three days off from January 23 to 25 in accordance with established rules. January 27 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; February 4 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Peace Memorial Day	February 27 February 28	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. February 27 (Monday) adjusts to holiday; March 3 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Children's Day Tomb-sweeping Day	April 4	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Labor Day	May 1	Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.

Dragon Boat Festival	June 23	Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Saturday, a deferred day off is not allowed.
Mid-autumn Festival	September 30	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, a deferred day off is not allowed.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 10	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	September 31 January 1,2013	Monday Tuesday	September 31 (Monday) adjusts to holiday; September 22 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
