Lunar New Year's Eve	February 18	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Spring Festival	February 19 February 20 February 21 February 22 February 23	Thursday Friday Saturday Sunday Monday	Three days off from February 19 to February 21 in accordance with established rules. As one of Spring Festivals falls on Saturday, February 23 (Monday) should be the day off to make it up.
Peace Memorial Day	February 27 February 28	Friday Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Saturday, February 27 (Friday) should be the day off to make it up.
Children's Day	April 3 April 4	Friday Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Saturday, April 3 (Friday) should be the day off to make it up.
Tomb-sweeping Day	April 5 April 6	Sunday Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, April 6 (Monday) should be the day off to make it up.

Labor Day	May 1	Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Dragon Boat Festival	June 19 June 20	Friday Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Saturday, June 19 (Friday) should be the day off to make it up.
Mid-autumn Festival	September 27 September 28	Sunday Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, September 28 (Monday) should be the day off to make it up.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 9 October 10	Friday Saturday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Saturday, October 9 (Friday) should be the day off to make it up.
